**HEMIS FESTIVAL, LADAKH***July 11-12, 2019*


This summer, plan a trip to the vast highland desert of Ladakh in the far north of India to catch the flamboyant Hemis festival. During this time, the nooks and crannies of the town come alive with a burst of colour, activity, pomp and gaiety. This festival in the famous Hemis *Gompa* or monastery provides the perfect opportunity to blend with the locals and learn more about their culture. Celebrating the birth of *Padmasambhava*, the Tibetan saint – the festival marks the victory of good over evil. The highlight of the festival is the Tantric Buddhism rituals and the *Chaam* dance at the monastery. Dressed in traditional multi-hued brocade outfits and colourful intricate masks, the *lamas* (Tibetan monks) dance to the rhythmic beat of drums and trumpets. You must also take some time out to watch the sacred plays that are performed by the *lamas* – they are quite insightful! This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity and we highly recommend that you participate in the festivities. However, do remember Ladakh is a high altitude destination and physical fitness is of prime importance. Mark your calendar and book your tickets soon – the festival is not too far away!
