Hemis Festival, Ladakh (June 16th & 17th, 2024)

Have clients who are thinking of visiting India in the summer? Plan a trip to the vast highland desert of Ladakh in the far north of India to catch the flamboyant Hemis festival. During this time, the nooks and crannies of the town come alive with a burst of color, activity, pomp and gaiety. This festival is held in the famous Hemis *Gompa* or monastery and provides the perfect opportunity to blend with the locals and learn more about their culture. Celebrating the birth of *Padmasambhava*, the Tibetan saint – the festival marks the victory of good over evil (don't we need this now more than ever!). Travellers can also take some time out to watch the sacred plays that are performed by the *lamas* – they are quite insightful!

Peirce & Leslie recommends: The highlight of the festival is the *Chaam* (masked dance) where the *lamas* (Tibetan monks) dance to the rhythmic beat of drums and trumpets.



The Best of Rural Rajasthan at Chanoud Garh, Pali (Rajasthan)

A magnificent fort-palace steeped in history, **Chanoud Garh**, is located in a tiny village in Rajasthan between Jodhpur and Udaipur. The over 300-year-old palace hotel is the family home of Thakur Ajeet Singh and his family who still live in a separate wing in the palace. It is spread across two central courtyards and comprises just ten suites, each unique in its design and thoughtfully restored to showcase the history of this intriguing fort. Chanoud Garh is the perfect off-the-beaten-track stop during a busy tour through Rajasthan and offers one a rare opportunity to see life in rural India. They also offer a range of cultural excursions for in-house guests including, celebrating local festivals with the family, a cooking class, visits to the local village and surrounding farmlands where you can interact with the shepherds and their families, and an open jeep sunset safari to the nearby salt flats. *Note: The heritage palace hotel does not have a pool and is closed from May to August every year*.
